





Have you ever wondered where the rainbow starts or ends?

Imagine you are in your house looking out the window on a rainy day. Then when the rain stops, you look up the sky and see some colour-curved lines together.

Rainbows are one of the greatest gifts we got from nature. People like it and enjoy seeing it so much that they have used it to decorate children's rooms and schools. Other people write beautiful stories, music or songs when they see the rainbow because it gets them inspired.

Well, that's the rainbow! And... did you know that it is the combination of rain drops (water) and sunlight (light)?

Rainbows are formed when sunlight passes through water. This action forms a reflection; it's like a reflection in a mirror.

All the colours that you know come from combinations of the colours in the rainbow. The rainbow has seven basic colours; red, orange, yellow, green, blue, light blue and violet. When you combine some of the basic colours, you can obtain new ones!





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




# A daily tour








# My NBF horse

Tommy thought about his dad idea and then he said, "Dad, I can't call it any other name, I like it!"


All the family liked the strange and funny name so much that they decided to give the robot a special place, just for it.
