1. Growth and germination

Topic: Plant growing

Objective: Observe the process of germination of a seed and be able to describe characteristics.

Vocabulary: seed, cotton, germinate, grow, roots.

Material:

- Seeds (Example: Bean)
- Water
- A small or medium glass bottle/jar
- Cotton

Development:

1. Make a cotton ball.



2. Put 2 or 3 seeds in a cotton ball.



3. Cover the seeds lightly with the cotton.



4. Put some water on the cotton ball with the seeds in it.



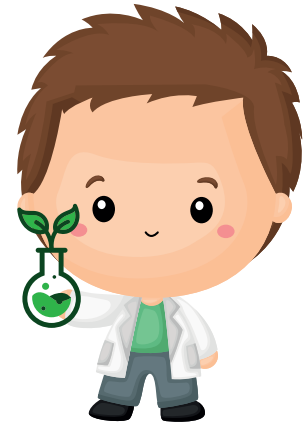
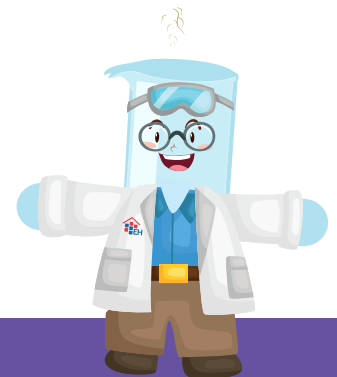
5. Put the cotton ball with the seeds in the jar.



6. Wait about a week until the seed starts to germinate.



7. Change the bottle for a pot when it has grown enough.
