WILL

*Show what we think may happen in the future = **Our prediction**

*Decisions that suddenly come = **When we make a sudden decision.**

GOING TO

*Something is going to happen very soon = **It's so obvious.**

*Our plans or intentions = **Planning to**



Mike **is** _____ stay at the hospital for a while, he needs extra care.

My sister **is** _____ come home on holidays.

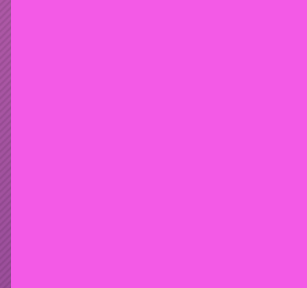
