[REGULAR VERBS - IRREGULAR VERBS – VERB TO BE]

REGULAR VERBS

[Verb –ed]

- (+) S + Verb in Past + C
- (-) S + did not + verb in infinitive + C
- (?) Did + S + verb in infinitive + C ?

guitar for fun.

IRREGULAR VERBS

[Different Verb Form]

- (+) S + Verb in Past + C
- (-) S + did not + verb in infinitive + C
- (?) Did + S + verb in infinitive + C ?



She _____ (take) us
to the cinema.

VERB TO BE

[was / were]

- (+) S + was / were + C
- (-) S + was / were not + verb in infinitive + C
- (?) Was / Were + S + C ?



They _____ (be)
happy with their dog.

- (-) S + did not + verb in infinitive + C
- (?) Did + S + verb in infinitive + C ?



She **took** us to the cinema.

VERB TO BE

[was / were]

- (+) S + was / were + C
- (-) S + was / were not + verb in infinitive + C
- (?) Was / Were + S + C ?



They **were** happy with their dog.
