E.g. Anna **put on** the coat.



Queue up

Wait for something in a line



E.g. Some people **queued up** all night to get into the store.

Shop around

Compare prices before buying



E.g. We often **shop around** for the best deal.

Take off

Remove a piece of clothing



E.g. He **took off** my wet boots and made me sit by the fire.

Pop into

To visit briefly



E.g. I'm going to **pop into** the store for a moment.

Try out

Test something to see if you like it



E.g. John hopes to **try out** his new running shoes this weekend.

Try on

Put on a piece of clothing to see if it fits



E.g. You should **try** the shoes **on** before you buy them.
