REGULAR VERBS

Description

We use the Past Continuous to talk about actions that happened in the _____ but went on for a period of time.

Past Continuous Tense = Past Progressive Tense

was - were

wasn't - weren't

+

Verb + ing

AGLD + IUB

We were waiting for the bus when we saw a car accident.

past future

past continuous: were waiting

simple past: saw

Past Continuous Tense

Time Clauses: When & While



WHEN ACTION + ACTION

WHILE
ACTION + ACTION
at the same time

WHEN

Shows what was occurring and what was happening at the moment another activity occurred.

E.g.

I was watching T.V. when my father came home.

When you called me_ I was washing the dishes.

WHILE

• Shows that two actions were occurring at the same time. E.g.

I was watching T.V. **while** my father was waiting in the kitchen. **While** I was washing some dishes_ you were cleaning the hall.

To talk about actions that are not related at all.

E.g.

While I was studying English_ my sister was chatting with her friends. **While** I was talking on the phone_ my mom was cooking.

Negative (-)
Interrogative (?)




Past Continuous (SUMMARY)



We use the Past Continuous to talk about actions that happened in the past but went on for a period of time.

was - were

Past Continuous Tense
=
Past Progressive Tense





WHEN

Shows what was occurring and what was happening at the moment another activity occurred.

E.g.

I was watching T.V. when my father came home.

When you called me, I was washing the dishes.

WHILE

- Shows that two actions were occurring at the same time.
- E.g.

I was watching T.V. while my father was waiting in the kitchen. While I was washing some dishes, you were cleaning the hall.

· To talk about actions that are not related at all.

E.g.

While I was studying English, my sister was chatting with her friends.

While I was talking on the phone, my mom was cooking.
