# To imagine life is different Things in the FUTURE that are UNLIKELY. E.g. If I \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ 10 million dollars, I'd buy a house. Things that are IMPOSSIBLE in the PRESENT E.g. If I \_\_\_\_\_\_ enough money, I would travel around the world. Hypothetical questions E.g. If you \_\_\_\_\_\_ go to Europe, where would you go?

E.g. If I \_\_\_\_\_ you, I would buy the tickets.

E.g. If I \_\_\_\_\_ time, I would go with you.

# E.g. I would = I'd I was/were

would = 'd

**IMPORTANT** 

**NOTES** 

He was/were
She was/were
It was/were

Just in this case, you can use were with these pronouns.

WERE is more formal.

# Affirmative (+) Negative (-) Interrogative (?)

2nd Conditional

	If +S+past simple, + C + S+would/could+ verb infinitive + C	If +S+past simple ,+ S+would/could+not+ verb infinitive + C	If + S + past simple , would + S + verb infinitive + C ?
		If + S + didn't +verb infinitive, + S + would/could + not + verb infinitive + C	
	E.g. If I worked out, I would a healthy life.	E.g. If I paid my bills, I would not problems with the bank.	What <b>would</b> you <b>do</b> if you your exam?

**NOTE:** When the sentence starts with IF, use a comma to separate the 2 ideas, when IF is in the middle of the sentence, you don't use a comma.

E.g. If I were you, I would do it. / I would do it if I were you.


#### SUMMARY

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Conditional

- 1. To imagine life is different
  - Things in the FUTURE that are UNLIKELY.
    - E.g. If I found 10 million dollars, I'd buy a house.

Things that are IMPOSSIBLE in the PRESENT

- E.g. If I had enough money, I would travel around the world.
- 2. Hypothetical questions
  - E.g. If you could go to Europe, where would you go? What would you do if you travelled to Africa?
- 3. Give advice
  - E.g. If I were you, I would buy the tickets.
- 4. Give reasons why
- E.g. If I had time, I would go with you.



**NOTE:** When the sentence starts with IF, use comma to separate the 2 ideas, when IF is in the middle of the sentence, you don't use a comma. E.g.

**If** I were you, I **would** do it. I **would** do it if I were you.

#### IMPORTANT NOTES

would = `d E.g. I would = I'd

I was/were He was/were She was/were It was/were

Just in this case, you can use were with these pronouns.

WERE is more formal.
