Frequency

E.g.:

Definite time

E.g.:

Frequency

be (am/is/are) + adverb

I **am always** happy.

adverb + verb

They **sometimes** drink milk.

verb + adverb + verb

She **is always** studying in the library.

Adverb - Frequency

always	----->	100%
almost always	--->	95%
usually / often	-->	80%
sometimes	----->	50%
seldom /		
not very often	--->	20%
rarely	----->	10%
almost never	----->	5%
never	----->	0%

Definite time

*Usually go in end-position

I'm going to Brazil **tomorrow**.

*The front position is possible if the adverb is not the main point of the sentence.

Tomorrow I'm going to Brazil.
