Adverbs (Degree & Place)

ADVERBS

*They are words that can describe verbs, adjectives, other adverbs or entire sentences.

*Adverbs of degree describe adjectives.

E.g. You are very hungry.

*Adverbs of place describe where something happens, be directional, refer to distances, indicate an object's position, express idea of location.

E.g. The wallet is there, can you find it?

That lion is pretty fast.

verb to be + not + adverb + adjective

She is not very happy.

Cockroaches are not extremely cute.

That lion is not pretty fast.
