Adverbs (Direction & Sequence)

Description

ADVERBS

*They are words that can describe verbs, adjectives, other adverbs or entire sentences.

*Adverbs of **direction** (prepositions) describe the location of places, and answer the question “where...?”

*Adverbs of **sequence** show the order of steps in a process or events in a story.

Direction

E.g.:

1. I would love to be in South Korea, I've never been **there**.

2. The roof garden is **upstairs**.

Sequence

E.g.:

1. **First** brush your teeth, **then** go to sleep.

2. Clean your room please, **after that** you can hang out.

Adverbs (Direction & Sequence)

Description

Direction

verb to be (am, is, are) + adverb
The cat is **downstairs**.

verb + adverb
She ran **upstairs** to the bathroom.
You turn **right** onto Prince Road.

Adverbs

everywhere anywhere somewhere
nowhere abroad away
here there indoors outdoors
inside outside upstairs downstairs
up down home back in out etc...

Sequence

adverb + verb
Sentence 1 + adverb + verb
First copy the homework, **then** answer it.

Adverbs

first next then after
after that finally
etc...


