Present Perfect Simple

Description

1. An action, situation or event that happened in the past but continues in the present

E.g.: I have painted my face.

2. An action, situation or event that stopped recently

E.g.: I have cleaned my nose.

3. To emphasize on the result

E.g.: I have learnt 5 languages.

4. An action, situation or event has taken place once, never, or several times

E.g.: I have never been to Asia.

PRESENT PERFECT SIMPLE

[AFFIRMATIVE]

S + have/has +
verb past participle + C

[NEGATIVE]

S + have/has + not +
verb past part + C

have not = haven't
has not = hasn't

[INTERROGATIVE]

Have/Has+ S +
verb past part + C ?

PRESENT PERFECT SIMPLE (Short answers)

[AFFIRMATIVE]

Yes, + S + have/has

[NEGATIVE]

No, + S + have/has + not

have not = haven't

has not = hasn't

Present Perfect Simple (SUMMARY)

1. An action, situation or event that happened in the past but continues in the present

S + have/has +

[NEGATIVE]

S + have/has + not +
verb past part + C

have not = haven't
has not = hasn't

[INTERROGATIVE]

Have/Has + S +
verb past part + C ?

PRESENT PERFECT SIMPLE (Short answers)

[AFFIRMATIVE]

Yes, + S + have/has

[NEGATIVE]

No, + S + have/has + not

have not = haven't

has not = hasn't
