

## Speaking 1

In this part of test, students will:

- write complete questions.
- ask and answers questions – personal information / details.

### Previous preparation

Get some things you can use to decorate the classroom – “Making new friends party”

### Start

- Show the items to the class and ask students to name them.
- Tell students that they will have 5 minutes to decorate the classroom.
- Ask students to describe the room.

### Role-play

- Tell students that they have been invited to a party and that all the people who were invited don't know each other.
- Play some party music and tell students to make new friends by asking for some personal information.

### During

- Ask students to tell you what questions they used and write them on the board.
- Check the questions are written correctly – whole-class check.
- Ask students to tell you what information must be provided by each.
- Explain to students that in the “Speaking 1” activity, they will be asked to provide personal information.
- Draw a chart on the board and write the following gapped questions. Then ask students to: write the missing words.
