## Speaking 2

In this part of the test, students will:

- talk about local events.
- write questions by using question prompts.
- ask and answer questions using the information provided - factual information.


## Previous preparation

Get some flyers from the internet about real upcoming events in the city.

## Start

- Students brainstorm - school and local events - write ideas on the board.
- Write on the board some prompts for students to provide information (downwards): type of event
when
where
how much
etc.


## During

## Pair work

Ask students to look at the activity on page 26 and 27 - students read, underline and write.

## Ex.

## Life museum

More than 50 airplanes to look at - what see?
What can people see at the museum?
People can see more than 50 airplanes.

- Ask students to practise making and answering questions.


## Finish

- Hand out the flyers and ask students to find 3 events they may be interested in.
- Make some questions about the events.
- Invite some students to:
talk to the class about the events they got interested in. provide detailed information about them.
