Pages 15 - 20

Start

Ask ss to look at the picture on page 15.

Make some questions in order to get ss describing it.

- **What is this man's work?**
- **What pet does he have?**
- **What is he holding in his right hand?**
- **What do pirates look for?**
- **Etc.**

Tell ss that they must use the numbers next to the words to label the picture of the pirate.

Hold up the book so all ss can see what you are pointing at.

- **What is this? (Pointing at the hat).**
- **Etc.**

During

Ask ss to look at the picture on page 17.

Ask them if they know / have an idea of what the kids are playing.

Ask some other random questions like...

- **Why only one kid has a pirate hat on?**
- **What are the things behind the couch?**
- **How are the kids using the couch?**
- **Etc.**

Tell ss to share some ideas on what the text may be about.

Write ss' ideas on the board.

Get some ss reading by paragraphs – at the end of each paragraph, make a question about it.

Ex

- **How old is Lucy?**
- **How many sisters / brothers does she have?**
- **What's her mum's / dad's name?**
- **Etc.**

Play the audio – get ss listening and following in their books.

Ask ss if they heard some background noises – what were they?

Tell ss that it is time for them to answer some questions about the text.

T reads question 1 and prompts what information ss must look for.

Do the same with the other two questions.

Write the word “who” on the board, and then make emphasis on it being used to talk / refer to people.

T says...

- **Kids, Who, this word is for people.**
- **So... Mum and dad, Nick and Sam or Grandpa and grandma... Who helps Lucy...?**

Do the same with the other two questions.

Ask ss to look at the pictures on page 19.

Ss name the things, and then T makes the question...

So, kids, the pillow, it was mentioned in the text?

Yes – circle
No – do nothing

End

Have a talk about playing “Be the pirate.”

Get ss coming up with ideas, and then use that information to complete the last activity.

Ex

- 1 – circle yes or no
- 2 – a stuffed bird
- 3 – the garden
- 4 – the garden – a haunted island
- 5 – my video games console

“Use L1 for the talking if necessary, then, when it is done, explain to ss how you are translating their ideas into L2.
