

Awesome Kidz 2

Unit 4 Lesson 8



Aim: Students will review vegetable vocabulary (potato, tomato, onion, cucumber, carrot), practice visual matching skills, and strengthen fine motor coordination by colouring. They will reinforce recognition and pronunciation through interactive and reflective activities.

Time: 45-60 minutes

Materials:

- Crayons or coloured pencils
- Real or plastic vegetables (optional)
- String and clips (optional for a hanging matching game)
- Background music (optional)
- Playdough

Tip: Review the names of the vegetables before the matching activity. Let students touch or handle real vegetables to reinforce vocabulary. Repeat and echo the words together using rhythmic or musical intonation to build retention and fluency.

Engage:

Vegetable Flash Show

-Hold up plastic or real vegetables and ask: "What is this?" "Is it red or green?". Use gestures and repetition: "This is a cucumber. Let's say it together!". Let students pass around the vegetables and describe them using words or actions.

Explore & Practice:

With the Book

Match & Colour

-Distribute books. Guide students to draw a line from the coloured vegetable to the correct black-and-white version. Say the name of each vegetable aloud together as a class: "Find the carrot. Now match it." After matching, students colour the black-and-white vegetables using correct colours.

Vegetable Clip Match Game (optional)

-Prepare cards with coloured vegetables and another set with black-and-white drawings. Hang them on a string across the classroom. Ask students to use clothespins to match each item, describing what they are doing: "This is a tomato. I match it here."

Closing:

What's Your Favourite? Mini Poster

- Give students playdough to make their favourite vegetable from the lesson. Ask them to stand up and share in a sentence: "I like potatoes." "My favourite is the carrot."
- Display their vegetables in the classroom.

Optional Goodbye Chant

*"Potato brown, and carrots bright,
Tomatoes red, oh what a sight!
Cucumbers long, onions round –
We matched them all, we're veggie-bound!"*
